Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height division. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

MEASURING AND HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured at any trial necessary. It is also the exhibitor's responsibility to mark their entry form correctly as to measuring status. Be sure to refer to Agility Rules and Regulations for full details

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate in this trial.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under **four** months of age are prohibited from the trial grounds.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. M.A.D. Agility Equipment is within all specs to AKC requirements. 24" spaced weaves, break-away tires and contacts rubberized. **Ring sizes will be 75' x 110'**.

MEASURING OFFICIALS

The judge of record is not a VMO and will measure dogs just for this weekend's trial. It is the exhibitors responsibility to see they get their measurement done if needed before their run.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Club will add a \$35.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Bitches in season will be awarded a refund, **less \$10.00/run processing fee**. Notification in writing (including a veterinarian's certificate) must be given to the trial secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial. Notifications in writing can be emailed to the TS if not attending the trial but must still be received 30 minutes prior to the start of the first class.

Injured dogs or handlers will be awarded a refund less **\$10.00/run processing fee** with a veterinary / physician's certificate. Physician's Certificate should be mailed or emailed to the trial secretary prior to trial, or personally presented to trial secretary prior to the commencing of judging.

Teams that withdraw due to COVID or other contagious disease, after the closing date, will be awarded a refund, **less \$10.00/run processing fee**. Exhibitors who want to withdraw due to any contagious disease must notify the secretary by 10:00 PM on the closing date to receive a full refund. Any notifications after that time will receive a partial refund.

Note: Any refund request other than those listed must be directed to the Club as the Trial Secretary is only authorized to accept and submit refunds for those types listed here.

Trial Secretary will not be held responsible for entries or changes not received at all or not received by any deadline. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to follow up on any correspondence with the Trial Secretary before any deadline date. If you do not get an email reply back from the Trial Secretary it most likely means she did not get your correspondence and you need to try to contact her again using an alternative form of communication.

ADDITIONAL EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

1. **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES PERMITTED ON SHOW GROUNDS.**
2. **All dogs must be on leash when not competing in the ring or at the practice jump.**
3. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.
4. Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are familiar with AKC agility rules and regulations and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
5. Telegraph, telephone, email, AKC online entries, fax, and unsigned entries will not be accepted.
6. All calls to the Trial Secretary must be before 1 PM Mon – Fri or 9am-9pm Sat / Sun.
7. Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules printed on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT VALID.
8. Postdated checks and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The club treasurer will add a collection fee of **\$35.00** to the amount of each returned check.
9. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms. Entry fees do not have to be refunded in event of such error.
10. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs at the show site. Failure to do so will result in dismissal.
11. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
12. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up the judging schedule. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the agility ring when they are called to be judged.
13. It is expressly understood that every dog and child at this trial are in the care, custody and control of its owner, handler, or parent during the entire time the dog or child is on the trial premises. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or child create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made.
14. Neither club nor the show site facility or its members are responsible for the loss of, damage to, or death of any dog exhibited, or the possessions of any participant, whether the result of accident or any other cause.
15. Declination of Entries: The NNKC may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove dogs on account of disease, viciousness or other causes and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any affiliate / official thereof.
16. **Trial Secretary is not responsible for incorrect information on any entry. Trial Secretary is not responsible for entries or emails not received on time or not received at all. Trial Secretary is also not required to accept any entry that does not have the proper fees included or the form is not fully/ correctly filled out.**
17. Treasurer may opt to mail any refunds due after the trial.

DAY TO DAY MOVE UPS

Per American Kennel Club Regulations for Agility Trials, dogs may be moved up to a higher class, at the request of the Owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title.

Before the trial, move-ups may be made prior to the move-up deadline via email to ckrotteez@comcast.net or USPS in writing to Cyndi Kepner / NNKC, 118 School St., Burnham, PA 17009. Verbal move ups will not be accepted.

Move ups prior to a set of trials are due in writing by Monday, 5/26/2025 at 6 pm.

Day-to-Day Move-ups WILL BE ACCEPTED. The request for moving up must be made in writing at the trial site to the Trial Secretary not later than the day preceding the event. On trial days, requests must be submitted in writing within 15 minutes after the last run of the trial day for the following day(s) and cannot be conveyed via fax, email, phone or verbally. Forms will be available at the site close to the Results Posting area.

Before the deadline, YOU MAY SIMPLY EMAIL A MOVE UP TO THE TRIAL SECRETARY but you must be sure the trial secretary **acknowledges the request with a return reply to your email.**

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO) (as of July 1, 2024)

FEO is offered at these trials!

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is allowed in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered at any level (Novice, Open Excellent or Masters) in FAST, JWW, Standard or Premier classes. If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge.
- Course time for FEO in Time 2 Beat, JWW, Standard, Premier and ISC will be 45 seconds. FAST courses times for each class/height are as noted in the Regulations.

Fix and Go On

- Allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note.
- Using **Fix and Go On** will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run.

Reminder for Mixed Class entries:

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day
Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.
